Getting to Know You Nancy Bjerstedt - Travel on Park

New KWN member Nancy Bjerstedt has been in the travel industry for a long time! She is currently the owner of Travel On Park, a home-based travel agency. The picture you may have of a travel agency is probably



a storefront with lots of glossy brochures, but, in fact, home based agencies are becoming the norm today! As Nancy says, most people look for deals on line and no one goes to the mall to look for a travel agent these days. Having her business in the home allows her to cut her overheads and still service her customers. She is associated with a large "Host Agency" called Uniglobe, which allows her to get better pricing for her clients, just like the big companies do.

So what are the advantages of using a travel agent when there are so many web based companies that allow you to "do it yourself"? Well, you are dealing with a real person, an expert, who will help you book your dream vacation through reputable companies.
