Despite the pandemic causing the cancellation of almost all out fundraising events last year, KWN was pleased to be able to award \$5,500 in mini grants to a total of 6 organizations, at the July meeting!

Pictured above are the representatives of those organizations, along with KWN President, Roseann Shales and Mini Grant Committee Chair, Alicia Fosbinder. Distribution was as follows:

Kenosha Public Museum: \$1,500	The Shalom Center: \$850
The Boys and Girls Club: \$900	Society's Assets: \$500
The Woman's Club: \$1000	Three Harbors Boy Scouts: \$750
